2016 SAUVIGNON BLANC



At long last, 2016 brought the Central Coast some much-needed rain. Steady precipitation in January started rejuvenating our soils, and big storm systems in March gave the vines a healthy start to the growing year. Hot spells in late June and late July combined with continued water-stress effects from the drought, lead to small berry size, making 2016 a year of great flavor intensity and vivid color. The winter rains arrived in October, allowing hangtime for our early ripening reds, and bringing cooler weather for our late-ripening varieties. Overall, the flavors of 2016 are robust and classic, with big tannins and fresh acidity that should allow the wines to continue to develop as they age.
